That's why there are different KONG® Rubber formulas graded from soft and pliable to firm to cater to a variety of chewing needs. Between the different grades of rubber there are a number of sizing options, situating owners in a position to help find the right KONG® to suit an individuals' play needs.

Dogs who demonstrate intense enthusiasm for chew style play are often better suited to firmer products with a larger, rounder surface area.



By continually selecting larger, rounder shaped rubber products we may better accommodate a powerful chewers needs. Increased surface area will make it more difficult for the individual to apply the same level of compression over the toy.

Safety first – KONG $^{\odot}$ recommends frequent inspection of all toys for wear and tear. Toys showing signs of wear should be discarded and replaced.
